We are an all male, 18-bed residential facility providing emergency and transitional housing, three meals a day, clothing and hygiene products, and supportive services.

### ***Daily Hot Lunch Program Offered at Settlement House: Coordinator, Kathy Chamberlin***

The Daily Hot Lunch Program operates Monday through Thursday from 12 am to 1 pm. The program is operated by volunteers both in the collection of donated items and the preparing of daily hot lunches. In addition to providing and serving lunch, also offered are services to meet the basic human needs of those living in the homeless community.
