CLAIRVAUX FARM



Clairvaux Farm provides emergency and transitional residential shelter services for persons experiencing a period of homelessness in their lives. We provide services for families as well as for single men and women on our 21 acre facility located outside of Earleville, Maryland. In addition to providing shelter, we also provide 3 meals per day, case management, and assistance to obtain medical, mental health, substance use treatment, transportation to work or school, and other services. We ask those who come to Clairvaux Farm to participate fully in the life of the community, and to develop a plan that addresses issues such as employment, education and financial well being. All residents are encouraged to deepen their spiritual connections while at Clairvaux Farm and are invited to participate in the regular worship life of the community.

The Farm has a dormitory building to house single women and single men, and a "Family House" that provides accommodations for families. In addition, there is program space, and a large dining hall with a commercial kitchen. The "Little Portion Chapel", which is located at Clairvaux Farm, is the center of worship for the Meeting Ground community and was rebuilt in 2010 – 2011 with the help and assistance from visiting work groups from churches and colleges. The "Mission House" provides accommodations for visiting work groups.

Meeting Ground operates a food closet at the Farm which provides food boxes to persons who are hungry in the community. We also use the Farm as a distribution point for clothing and household goods that are needed by persons in the community.

DIRECTIONS TO CLAIRVAUX FARM: Take Rt. 213 south from Elkton. Travel approximately 12 miles. Almost immediately after crossing over the Bohemia River, make a right onto Glebe Road. Follow Glebe Road for approximately 2 miles and turn right onto Cherry Grove Road. Travel approximately 1 mile and turn right onto Veazey Cove Road.
